A new scholarship opportunity for our 2020 Conference!

A limited number of COVID-19 scholarships are available to Texas PRIMA public entity members who are unable to attend due to budget cuts in FY20 and/or FY21. An application must be completed with a letter from the Public Entity Member's supervisor explaining the need. To be eligible for this scholarship, the Texas PRIMA membership dues must still be paid for 2021 and the public entity member must have attended two of the last three conferences.
